Computerized is not always better and the most expensive isn't always best for what you're doing. If you aren't quilting you don't need a machine made for that!

Great Brands: Brother, Bernina, Janome, Pfaff, Singer

Features to consider:

Stitch length: Adjustable dial or as a stitch option

Important Stitch options: straight, stretch, zigzag, blind hem, overlock

Buttonholes: Automatic or step by step

Free Arm allows you to sew smaller openings i.e. sleeves, cuffs
