The more you spend will have extra features that can grow with you but they can also confuse you in the beginning. Computerized is not always better and the most expensive isn't always best for what you're doing. If you aren't quilting you don't need a machine made for that!

Great Brands: Brother, Bernina, Janome, Pfaff, Singer

Features to consider:

Stitch length: Adjustable dial or as a stitch option

Important Stitch options: straight, stretch, zigzag, blind hem, overlock

Buttonholes: Automatic or step by step

Free Arm allows you to sew smaller openings i.e. sleeves, cuffs
